Start/Finish	///billiard.yelled.reheat	Hampton Estate event village start/finish point.
CP1	///having.time.skills	Waypoint opposite entrance to footpath park Moor Park House.
CP2	///caravans.breaches. sideboard	Stockbridge car park. Portaloos available in field.
CP3	///ditching.trying.flushes	No vehicles, waypoint only.
CP4	///notfiying.message. yesterday	Overflow car park at National Trust's Devils Punch Bowl Visitor centre. Café and WC's on site. Tickets must be bought for car parking.
CP5	///consults.solder.emu- lating	No vehicles, waypoint only.
CP6	///amicably.boss.wink	St Dominic's School, Hambledon. Visitors WC on site available.
CP7	///hopefully.hands.dwell	Field opposite Gatestreet Barn, portaloos on site. Vehicle access is via the top (Northern) end of Gatestreet: then turn left and follow track through car park and wooden gate, round the corner of the wood.
CP8	///photo.eaten.cages	Small checkpoint on verge adjacent to Rooks Hill Farm. No cars or WC facilities.
CP9	///forest.crown.cold	Halfpenny lane car park in the churchyard at St Martha's Church. Portaloos in the car park.
CP10	///worker.dull.flag	Piccard's farm. Portaloos available.

## What to do in an emergency

# Seek help. Call 999 in the event of an emergency. In case of accident make a note of all relevant details:

- Location (What3Words location if possible).
- Name, gender and age of casualty.
- Nature of injuries or emergency.
- Number of people in the party.
- Your mobile phone number.
- If you require mountain rescue you must request 'police' then 'mountain rescue'
- Give all your prepared details of the incident.
- Do NOT change your position until contacted by the rescue team.
- Ensure you and your team are in no further danger.
- Make an initial assessment of the situation and any injuries then apply First Aid as necessary.

# Ensure at least one person must always remain with the casualty.





## Health and safety advice

What to pack in your first aid kit: Each team member should have a basic first aid kit containing the following:

- Scissors
- Antiseptic wipes
- Compeed blister plasters
- Zinc oxide tape 1 roll (used to tape feet to prevent blisters.)
- Microlin tape 1 roll (used to tape feet to prevent blisters.)
- Dioralyte 4 sachets
- Paracetamol 6 tablets suggested.
- Small pot vaseline (used to treat chafing.)
- Small bottle talcum powder (to prevent chafing of feet/toes.)
- Self-adhesive dressing strip 'Sticking plaster' strip.
