Complete these steps to earn your Explorers Fundraising Badge!

1 Raise funds for Cystic Fibrosis Trust and celebrate FeBREWary with your troop

Hold a FeBREWary party at your usual weeknight meeting. Enjoy some hot drinks around the campfire and bring the fun with a quiz or games' night! Why not invite your siblings, parents and guardians to join in and help make a difference for people with cystic fibrosis (CF)?

2 Think about why you're fundraising and how to tell people about cystic fibrosis (CF)

Maybe someone in your troop or family has cystic fibrosis and they can tell your troop more about it? Or you could challenge your troop to each find out one fact about CF?

3 Use social media to promote your FeBREWary event

4 Set a date and a fundraising target

FeBREWary lasts a whole month, so you've got plenty of dates to choose from. Think about how many people you can get to join in and consider the costs for your event. Scouts suggest a £500 minimum fundraising target for the Explorer badge, so think big!

5 Encourage others in your unit to join in

6 Give a presentation about your fundraising challenge and present to your leader or troop
