Schools Fundraising Tips

## **Get Inspired!**

- **Create a competition.** Set a challenge between classes to encourage competition with a prize for the winning class. Or even have a pupil's vs teachers' competition!
- Organise a sponsored fun run or walk. Organise playground walks or laps/ relays of the school field. Combine with a litter pick and be environmentally conscious with your sponsored walk/run by cleaning up the streets on your way.
- Sponsored walk to school week. Children will do better in class because they arrive refreshed, fit, and ready to learn as well as there being less congestion and air pollution from less cars driving to school.
- Fact hunt. Design your route where walkers must answer a question sheet about landmarks along the route e.g. what date a building was built or the names of shops and charge for entry.
- Treasure Hunt
- **Quiz Night.** Host a quiz online or in person. Start by inviting parents and teachers to enter individually or as teams.
- **Cake sale** tea, coffee and juice and sweet treats can be sold and donated by parents alongside a raffle.

- **Bingo.** Host a fundraising bingo night, online or in-person, where families can pay to play and try to win small prizes, or something bigger?
- School-Boot Market. Host a car boot sale, but it's held inside your school instead. Let families donate items from home, such as clothes, CD/DVDs, books, toys, even nick-nacks, then arrange them on tables and watch them sell.
- Your School's Got Talent! What school isn't bursting with talented children, teachers, and staff? Here's a great way to showcase all those budding singers, dancers, comics, magicians, and actors with your very own fundraising talent extravaganza.
- **Teacher Charity Game.** Organise a 'friendly' game of football, cricket, or rounders between teams of teachers. The children will love the chance to watch their favourite teachers compete (perhaps in fancy dress?)
