CP3	///amicably.boss.wink	Hambledon Village Hall. Lunch stop with food and drink available. Portaloos available.
CP4	///hopefully.hands.dwell	Wintershall Barn, toilets available in the barn.
CP5	///photo.eaten.cages	Small checkpoint on verge adjacent to Rooks Hill Farm. No cars or WC facilities.
