

Children's Christmas Card Competition 2016

Terms and Conditions

1. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust 2016 Children's Card Competition is open to children with cystic fibrosis under the age of 12 who either have cystic fibrosis, or who have a close relative with the condition. Children must be residents in England, Wales, Scotland or Northern Ireland.
2. Children of Cystic Fibrosis Trust staff members cannot enter the competition.
3. One entry per child only.
4. Entries will not be returned.
5. The closing date for entries is the 31st December 2016.
6. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust reserves the right to edit or adapt the drawings submitted.
7. The winner will not be entitled to any copyright of their submission.
8. The personal details provided by the parent/guardian on the entry form will be used by the Cystic Fibrosis Trust only. If the parent/guardian does not want to be contacted by the Cystic Fibrosis Trust in future they can opt-out of communications by ticking the relevant boxes on the entry form.
9. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust reserves the right to change or cancel this competition at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.

Hand drawn entries

11. Entries should be within the 160 x 160mm square on a form downloaded and printed from the following webpage: www.cysticfibrosis.org.uk/cardshop. The form should be fully completed and signed by the parent/guardian of the entrant to show acceptance of these terms and conditions.
12. Entries should be hand drawn and should be the child's own and original work. Raised materials like glitter and felt can be used but please note that the winning card image will need to be scanned and when it is remastered for print the final image will be a flat 2D image. Entries must not include any image that may breach copyright regulations e.g. cartoon characters, brand names etc.
13. Entries should be sent by post (unfolded) to: Cystic Fibrosis Trust, One Aldgate, London EC3N 1RE.

Photo or computer generated entries

14. Photograph entries and computer generated entries will also be accepted and can be sent by post (same address as above) or by email to Rachael.harris@cysticfibrosis.org.uk. Entries, whether postal or emailed, must include a completed and signed entry form to show acceptance of these terms and conditions by the parent/guardian.
15. Photograph entries should have a resolution of 300dpi or over and should be saved as a JPEG file.
16. Computer generated entries should be suitable for printing on a 160mm x 160mm card.
17. Photograph entries and computer generated entries should be the child's own and original work. Entries must not include any image that may breach copyright regulations e.g. cartoon characters, brand names etc.

18. Any entries not complying with these terms and conditions will not be put forward for judging. Organisers reserve the right to disqualify any entry at their absolute discretion.
19. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust accepts no responsibility for cards which are lost, damaged, illegible, received after the closing date or from which the prize-winner cannot be identified.
20. Judging will be carried out by Cystic Fibrosis Trust staff members and a representative from Impress Publishing (registered address: Appledown House, Barton Business Park, New Dover Road, Canterbury, Kent CT1 3TE).
21. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into regarding this decision.

The winner

22. The winner will be notified by phone and/or in writing (using details provided by the parent/guardian on the entry form) within one month of the closing date and their prize issued by post within 6 weeks of the closing date.
23. No cash or alternative prize will be available.
24. The parent/guardian of the winner may be contacted regarding publicity following the announcement of the winning image.
25. Unclaimed prizes: if for any reason the winner is not contactable for one month after the closing date or unable to collect the prize, a different winner will be selected.

26. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust reserves the right to publish the winning card and details of the win as and where deemed appropriate. This could include, but is not exclusive to, the Cystic Fibrosis Trust website, social media pages, offline materials and the printed card in the 2017 collection. Details of the win will include the name, age, counties of residence, and connection to cystic fibrosis of the entrant.

The winning card will be available to purchase from the Cystic Fibrosis Trust's 2017 card collection, both online and through the Christmas catalogue, which are supplied/hosted by Impress Publishing. Details of the winner will be included on the card including the name, age, counties of residence, and connection to cystic fibrosis of the entrant.
28. The Cystic Fibrosis Trust reserves the right to remove the winning card from the 2017 collection at any stage, if deemed necessary in its opinion, and if circumstances arise outside of its control.
29. The winning image may not be used elsewhere by the competition winner, their parent or guardian or any third party.
